The Education Department at the Morris Museum offers an internship program for undergraduate students majoring in museum studies, art administration, history, anthropology, art history, science education, or art education.

- Intern responsibilities will include:
 - Teaching workshops under the guidance of educators -- such as Open Art (Thursday night), Super Science Saturdays (Saturday morning), and Vacation Day Workshops
 - Researching and developing workshops and festivals
 - Staffing festival weekends, art exhibit openings, and other special programs
 - Creating brochures and flyers
 - Preparing for crafts and science experiments
 - Summer interns will assist educators to facilitate Morris Museum Summer Camp
- Interns must have office hours at the museum at least once a week
- This will be an unpaid internship
- College credit can be arranged if the student chooses, the school approves, and the internship meets all necessary university requirements
